Jesse Williams Jr. Memorial Scholarship Application

BACKGROUND:

The Jesse E. Williams III, Memorial Scholarship is a \$1,500 scholarship for youth who are wards of the San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department. It was established in October of 2001 at the request of Jesse E. Williams, Jr. Chief Probation Officer of the San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department from October 1, 1997 through June 18, 2003. It was created in honor of the memory of his son, Jesse E. Williams, III, who was the victim of a homicide.

ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS:

The Jesse E. Williams, III Memorial Scholarship Fund is to be used for tuition, books, registration fees, or other appropriate expenses related to the pursuit of an advanced educational degree, advanced job training which is directly linked to employment.

Eligible youth must be or have been wards of the San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department and will be considered in the following order:

- A. Graduates of Log Cabin Ranch School
- B. Other wards of the San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department

REFERRAL PROCESS:

Eligible youth must be referred by Deputy Probation Officers, Juvenile Hall Counselors, or Log Cabin Ranch Counselors who are full time employees in good standing with the San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department at the time that referrals are made.

Referrals will be screened by City Youth Now and, through their processes, recipients will be selected.

Application must be received in the City Youth Now office by 5:00 p.m. March 22, 2017.
